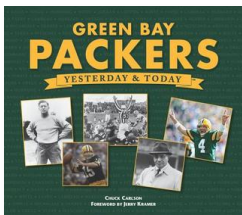
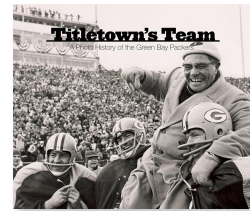
Before They Were Packers by Denis Gullickson — *If you are interested in the beginnings of football in Green Bay, this book is a must.*

Green Bay Packers: A Measure of Greatness by Eric Goska — *Packer history starts here with a comprehensive, season-by-season guide to the team on and off the field.*



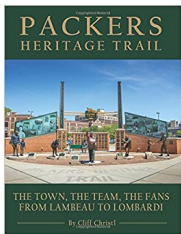
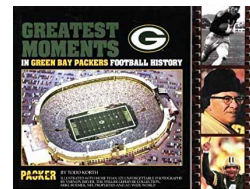
Lambeau: The Man Behind the Mystique by David Zimmerman — *The man who made it all possible and who led the Packers from 1919-1949.*

Titletown's Team: Photographic History of the Packers by the Green Bay Press-Gazette — *Great photos and stories from the archives of the team's hometown newspaper.*



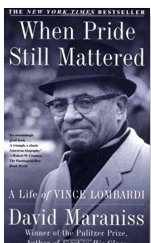
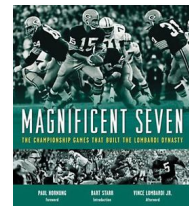
